SEND Transition Programme

We offer bespoke packages of 5 Day Provision for students with Learning Difficulties and/or Disabilities. The packages centre around an existing programme from our range of courses from Pre-Entry to Level 1. To be eligible, the young person must have an Education Health and Care Plan (or currently transferring from a Learning Disability Assessment) and be aged 16-24.
